UPA privatised taxpayers' money for one family: FM

Sitharaman was reacting to Rahul's tweet that the Centre is privatising profit and nationalising losses

New Delhi, 16 March

romising that interests of workers and the staff would be protected while privatising public sector units (PSUs), including banks, finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Tuesday said that the United Progressive Alliance (UPA) nationalised corruption and privatised taxpayers' money for the betterment of one family.

This statement was made by the finance minister to counter Rahul Gandhi's recent tweet where he said that the current government privatised profit and nationalised losses.

He had also said that he stands in solidarity with the striking bank employees, and that the government is selling public sector banks (PSBs) to cronies.

Sitharaman said, "Nationalising corruption and privatising taxpayers' monev for the betterment of one family is all that Rahul Gandhi has to take as a reply for that tweet, which probably he outsourced to some fellow in his team."

In her Cabinet briefing, she said PSBs are loss making due to "telephone" banking which happened during the UPA government.

"His dadi (grandmother, Indira Gandhi) had nationalised banks but nationalising of loss in banks was during the UPA's time," the finance minister

Cabinet nod to closure of PSU handicraft firm

The Cabinet approved the closure of Handicrafts and Handlooms Export Corporation of India (HHEC), a government undertaking under the administrative control of the textile ministry.

Employees in the corporation – 59 permanent and six management trainees – will be given an opportunity to avail voluntary retirement scheme, according to norms laid down by the Department of Public Enterprises. The approval will benefit the exchequer in reducing recurring expenditure on salary/wages of a sick central public sector enterprise (CPSE) which is not in operation and earning no income.

The corporation has been continuously incurring losses since 2015–16 and not earning sufficient income to meet its running expenses. There is little scope for its revival, necessitating closure, an official statement said.

The full cost of three cylinders was transferred in three instalments to the bank accounts of PMUY beneficiaries, who could then buy the cylinders at market

This had driven up the country's LPG consumption early on during the lock-

Currently, there is partial support for consumers in remote areas (usually far from LPG depots) and the Centre continues to subsidise the freight charges for these. However, the subsidy is under ₹30 per cylinder.

"I have got a refund (freight subsidy) of around ₹20 for the cylinders I book. This is too little and with no kerosene available, there is no option but to keep buying the expensive LPG cylinders," says a snack shop owner in Dibai, a small city around 140 km from Delhi.

The Centre has been phasing out kerosene and replacing it with LPG through the PMUY. In her Budget 2021 speech, Sitharaman announced that an additional 1 crore free cooking gas connections would be disbursed.

This was also the first budget with nil allocation for kerosene subsidy. But with high LPG prices, the government may find it difficult to ensure sustained adoption of cooking gas. But government-owned

oil marketing companies (OMCs) insist that LPG consumption has improved amongst PMUY customers. "It is notable that the improvement in the overall LPG consumption has continued for the three-month period of December 2020-Feb 2021 and has registered

Total outflows in equityoriented schemes in the last eight months stood at over ₹46.000 crore.

Industry players reckon the outflows may continue for a few more months, especially if the markets continue to make new highs and valuations remain rich.

"Mutual funds typically do not take significant cash calls. What that means is that our level of investment will be in line with the flows that we get. If the flows are negative, as it has been for the past few months, MFs will have to turn net sellers the market," said G Pradeepkumar, CEO,

The government had earlier come up with the National Infrastructure Pipeline, following recommendations by a taskforce.

एनसीएलएटी में इंटरप्स की याचिका खारिज
